Playwork Assistant (Sessional)

Job purpose: To support the Playworkers to provide rich, stimulating and enjoyable play experiences for small groups of deaf children aged 4 to 8 years, acting as an inspiring role model for the children at all times thus helping them to develop a positive sense of self-worth.

Key responsibilities

Direct Play

- 1. Support the Playworkers to facilitate high quality play experiences that are innovative, creative and challenging for deaf children aged 4 to 8 years at our premises in Belfast every Saturday (term time only)
- 2. Develop good relationships with the children and be a positive role model at all times, communicating with them appropriately and demonstrating empathy and understanding
- 3. Provide excellent standards of care at all times by supervising the children appropriately within a risks-benefits play framework and actively supporting their social and emotional wellbeing

Setting up the play space

- 4. Support the Playworkers to set up the play space and resources appropriately before each session begins and clear away at the conclusion of each session
- 5. Support the play team in creatively preparing and setting up the role play area (theme changes monthly) and fantasy play area (theme changes termly)

Liaison

6. Work in partnership with colleagues to support each individual child's holistic development

Other

7. Promote and safeguard the welfare of the children who attend our play programme and ensure all safeguarding and child protection procedures are adhered to
