The Engagement Officer will work on-site, closely collaborating with our team to develop and implement strategies that enhance our relationship with both current and potential members.

Greenhill YMCA is part of the YMCA Ireland movement, nestled in the foothills of Slieve Donard in Co Down. It is a 17-acre site with panoramic views over the town of Newcastle and Dundrum Bay. The YMCA has been delivering outdoor education programmes and activities here at Greenhill for over 100 years and it's the ideal place for any young person to fulfill their potential.

The YMCA's vision is a world where young people, their families and communities flourish in body, mind and spirit.
