Key Duties and Responsibilities

The key duties and responsibilities of the Climate Action Coordinator are as follows:

Encourage engagement from Community and Voluntary Organisations across County Fermanagh and Cavan on a programme of work in the area of Climate Change.

Recruit and support individuals on a cross-community basis to undertake climate leadership and climate action.

Encourage and support individuals to participate in training to become Climate Action Champions who will identify and drive climate action activity in their local areas.

Support the development of Local Community Energy initiatives

Develop a plan of action to respond to the needs identified by the Climate Action Champions.

Establish and grow a climate hub in Counties Fermanagh and Cavan as a one stop shop of information and advice for communities.

Support the development of greater North South collaboration around Climate Change.

Propose new Climate policy or concepts for consideration on a North-South basis.

Collaborate on an interagency level with other stakeholders including but not limiting to Fermanagh and Omagh District Council, Cavan County Council, Third level and other academic institutions, Government Departments, Community Based Organisations, and the relevant environmental bodies.

Identify funding opportunities to grow the climate remit of both The Fermanagh Trust and Cavan County Local Development.
