Overview

Orchardville is a voluntary organisation and registered charity that supports young people and adults with learning disability or autism to live, learn and work. Established in 1982 we offer high quality day opportunity and employment services to over 600 participants each year who attend services in Belfast, North Down, Lisburn and Derry/ Londonderry. The work we do is life-changing for participants, enabling them to lead independent lives, gain employment and become fully included in their community.

Main Responsibilities

The casual project worker is employed at our evening and weekend social groups in Belfast, Lisburn and North Down working either Thursday or Friday evenings or on a Saturday morning. You will:

- Support participants to engage in the various social activities including arts/crafts, quizzes, games, movies and cookery
- Support the project officer to ensure a safe and supportive environment is in place.

PERSONNEL SPECIFICATION

Essential Criteria

- 3 months experience of working with young people or adults with disability, paid or voluntary.

Desirable Criteria

- Emergency First Aid at Work training completed within the last 2 years.
- Food Hygiene Certificate completed within the last 2 years.
