**Essential Criteria**

- 2 years' experience working or volunteering with disadvantaged and vulnerable young people
- 1 years' experience in the delivery of group work programmes

**Desirable Criteria**

- Knowledge of issues affecting disadvantaged and vulnerable young people
- Knowledge of programmes or interventions to assist young people to overcome personal barriers
- Experience and or knowledge of being a 'NEET' young person or facing similar barriers in the past
- Commitment to organisational values, principles and to children's rights

- Community Youth Work Degree (or equivalent)


